As many of you know, it was on March 23, 1869, that a group of eight women met in Boston and, inspired by Clementina Butler and Lois Butler, found the Women's Foreign Missionary Society to raise funds and send educator Isabella Thoburn and Dr. Clara Swain to India. But that was just one strand that was woven together with the Woman's Missionary Association of the United Brethren Church (formed in 1875), two strong Woman's Home Missionary Societies (founded in 1880 and 1890). The Woman's Foreign Missionary Society of the Methodist Protestant Church (1879), and the Woman's Missionary Society in the Evangelical Association (1884).

Throughout our history, we have put our faith into action. We support mission needs internationally and nationally. We advocate for social justice. We work for responsible stewardship of God's creation. We offer learning opportunities and educational experiences because we believe that educated women can transform the world. Through our spiritual practices, we deepen our faith and nurture mind, body, and spirit.

Wisconsin United Women in Faith, we have important work to do. We need each of you and your God-given gifts to turn faith and love into action for women, youth, and children around the world.

Odell Thompson Remembered as Mission Giant

The Wisconsin Conference United Women in Faith lost one of our pillars of faith when Odell Thompson passed away on Dec.16, 2022. Odell was active in United Methodist Women at the local, district, conference, and national levels. Odell's former pastor, Rev. Mary Council-Austin, in her eulogy for Odell, remembered Odell as a woman of color in leadership roles in the business community, and in her retirement, "God would raise her up as a mission giant at home and around the world." Odell touched many of our lives, and we remember Odell as Rev. Mary describes her: an "encourager in ministry and life journey" and "grounded in her love for you and her unwavering belief in the beloved community." We will have a time of remembrance at our Annual Gathering in October.

Mabel Heil Scholarship Fund Wisconsin Conference

The Mabel Heil Scholarships are made possible by earnings from a trust established in the will of Sarah Mabel Heil, a resident of Cuba City, Wisconsin. Funds are awarded by the Heil Scholarship Committee of the Wisconsin Conference United Women in Faith and are invested in the Wisconsin United Methodist Foundation. Any Wisconsin United Methodist woman working to improve her education may apply.

Available Funds:

- a. Funds will be invested in the Wisconsin United Methodist Foundation, in a fund split 60 percent equity and 40 percent fixed.
- **b.** Funds available to provide scholarships for each semester will be calculated as 2.5 percent of the fair market value of the Mabel Heil Scholarship Fund as of the end of the month prior to the approval of Scholarships.

Eligibility Requirements:

- **a.** Must be a female member of the United Women in Faith and/or United Methodist Church, Wisconsin.
- **b.** Submit a written answer to the question, "In what ways do I consider myself a worthy student?"
- **c.** Letter of recommendation from either the president of the local UWFaith unit or from your pastor.
- **d.** Letter of recommendation from a church member who is not a member of your household and is not a relative. (Person writing letter on behalf of applicant is to send the letter directly to the contact person)
- **e.** All letters must be written (Preferably typed) on one side of an 8.5x11" sheet of white paper using black ink.

Application Procedures:

- a. Awarded for one semester at a time. To be considered again for any subsequent semester, send letter asking to be considered.
- b. Graduate students may apply for each semester as long as they meet the other requirements
- c. Application and two (2) letters of recommendation OR RECONSIDERATION LETTER must be received by May 1 for the fall semester or October 1 for the spring semester. Checks will be disbursed by August 15 and January 15.
