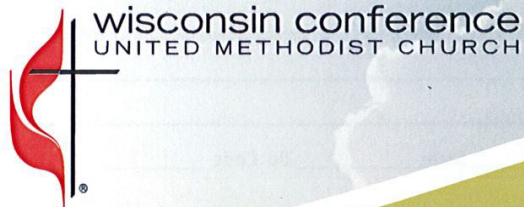
Red Bird Mission:
