

We are looking for someone who has a camera to take pictures of district activities, plus keep a file of our newsletters, annual gathering booklets, etc.


The position is for 4 years and will be appointed by the District President. You would be a member of the Executive Team without vote.





**DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO MISSION ACTION DAY AT TOMAH FIRST UMC:**

**Coming from the north on I-94:** Take the Tomah exit, turn right and that will be Hwy 12 or Superior Avenue. Continue on Superior Ave to Jackson Street or follow the hospital signs. Turn right on Jackson and go to the end of the street. You come to the hospital and turn left on Butts Avenue. Continue several blocks and the church is on the right across from the high school. The parking lot and main entrance is in the back of the church.

**Coming in on Hwy 21 from the east:** At the intersection of Hwy 21 and Hwy 12 turn left on Superior Ave and follow the above directions.

**Coming from the south:** Take I-90 where the I divides and take the first Tomah exit which comes in on Hwy 16. Continue to the first set of stoplights and turn right onto Superior Ave. Go to Juneau Street (Band Box Cleaners on the left, also a church sign) turn left and continue to 4th stop sign and turn right onto Butts Avenue. The church is on the left and parking lot is in the back. The church is across from the high school.

**Coming from the west:** Take the first Tomah exit, turn left (Hwy 131). Go to the first set of stoplights and continue on Superior Ave. to Juneau Street and follow the above directions.

# Mabel Heil Scholarship

The Mabel Heil Scholarships are a result of funds from the will of Sarah Mabel Heil, a woman from Cuba City, Wisconsin. The first scholarships were granted in 1981. Since then more than 240 women have received help with their education.

## Requirements and Instructions

### Instructions:

1. Be a female member of Wisconsin Conference United Methodist Women.
2. Submit a written answer to the question, "In what way do I consider myself a worthy student?"
3. Send the completed application form to the contact person by May 1 for the fall semester or October 1 for the spring semester.
4. Request that a letter of recommendation be sent to the contact person by the president of the local UMW or the pastor of the church.
5. Request that a letter of recommendation be sent to the contact person by a church member who is not a member of your household and is not a relative.

### Rules:

1. Any member of Wisconsin Conference United Methodist Women working to improve her education may apply.
2. Have all letters written (preferably typed) on one side of an 8 ½" by 11" sheet of white paper using black ink.
3. All applications are photo copied for committee members.
4. Scholarships are awarded one semester at a time. To be considered again DURING a one year period, you must send a letter asking to be considered. AFTER one year, you will need to fill out another form and secure new recommendations.
5. If in any given year there is an increase of applications, these priorities will be followed: Women responsible for others will be favored. Women preparing to return to the employment field will be favored.
6. The schedule is: **First Semester:** apply by May 1, notify by June, check given by August 15. **Second Semester:** apply by October 1, notify by November 1, check given by December 1.
7. Application and two letters of recommendation must be postmarked no later than May 1 and October 1 to be considered.
