## **Treasurer's Note**

United Women in Faith Treasurers,

At Assembly this year in Orlando, FL I happened to stop at the booth of the General Board of Discipleship. There they were handing out various free gifts. One which I happened to obtain was a copy of a yearlong devotional book named "Disciplines: A Book of Daily Devotions 2022". It is produced by The Upper Room. I must admit that although I was familiar with the Upper Room devotionals, I had never heard of "Disciplines". The woman handing out the free copies explained that it was written from a more progressive biblical stance than their more well-known devotional series. I must admit I was a bit skeptical. I am (as a rule) rather picky about my devotional books and rarely do I find the sort of generalized platitudes and stories to be found in daily devotions to be of interest to me. However, since the book was free, I brought it home and began to use it. I must admit that I was very pleasantly surprised. It isn't that I necessarily found every entry helpful, but I did find the emphasis on economic and social justice in relation to the liturgical calendar quite refreshing and often the reflections pushed me to think about how my own life should daily work to show love to my neighbors. I hope you are finding ways this year (and every year) to grow in your understanding of what God is calling you to do to build up the kin(g)-dom of God. For as James 2:16 says "faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead". I pray that you find more and more ways to have your faith be alive in the world. This is what we do as we work in mission to turn faith, hope and love into action all around the world. This is the true gift of Mission Giving.

Praise God, we are approaching something like a more normal giving pattern this year. We are currently at 41% of our pledge amount which is roughly where we were this time of year two years ago. Traditionally we hold the majority of our fundraisers at the end of the year, so we are within a reasonable range of our goal, but we will definitely need to see our units commit to doing their best to bring enthusiasm and inspiration to their projects this year. I hope you are also planning to come to District and/or Conference events this fall. We are very fortunate to have the Conference Annual Gathering in our District again. It is a valuable opportunity for you to see our organization and learn all of the latest about our new name and other new initiatives meant to bolster membership and engage with more women about our sisterhood. Please consider having your unit make a pledge in the next year. The form is included in this newsletter and while not required, is a helpful way to begin your budget discussions for your unit for 2023. I hope to see as many of you as possible this fall, but if you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me. Like Paul in Ephesians 1:16 "I have not stopped giving thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers." May you find God at work in all you do.
