



Join Bishop Jung's Interfaith Bus Tour and Retreat August 17-19, 2018

Bishop Hee-Soo Jung invites you to join him for an Interfaith Bus Tour and Retreat August 17-19, 2018. Our theme for the event is "Alike and Different: Understanding Real Religious Lives." On Friday evening, we will participate in the Shabbat service at Congregation Sinai in Milwaukee. On the following day, we will travel by bus from the DeKoven Retreat Center in Racine to Catholic, Serbian Orthodox, and Islamic worship centers in and around Milwaukee. On Saturday evening, Bishop Jung will lead us in a service of Holy Communion and time of reflection. On Sunday morning, we will take a tour of the MTO Shahmaghsoudi School of Islamic Sufism in Franksville. In the afternoon, we will participate in a dialogue with members of the Sikh and Muslim communities. The retreat will conclude with an interfaith service of meditation and prayer.

As we meet our religious neighbors and come to understand real religious lives, our own lives and understandings will be deepened. In the process, we will see how we are different and how we are alike.



PARTICIPATION GOALS

Registration is limited to 52 persons. Laity and clergy are both invited. The schedule begins in the evening Friday and ends before dinner on Sunday.

PROCESS

Bishop Hee-Soo Jung will speak to us during our travel time Saturday in a comfortable motor coach with restrooms. Comfortable accommodations, space for informal conversation, meeting rooms, and worship settings in the DeKoven Retreat Center will provide the environment for this inspiring retreat.

PREPARATION

All registrants will receive a packet by email containing important information, including directions about attire and principles of interfaith dialog.

Bishop Hee-Soo Jung and the Commission on Christian Unity and Interreligious Relationships have planned this event with the assistance of various religious leaders from greater Milwaukee.

OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS

Double rooms are \$75/night.
